Hunt Country Vineyards Classic Red is a beautifully-balanced medium-bodied Beaujolais-style red wine. We blend DeChaunac, Noiret and Rougeon grapes to produce a wine with a complex fruit character that is dry, smooth, low in tannins and modestly oaked.

The DeChaunac grape gives Classic Red a light flavor of raisins or plums, and the Noiret grape adds a hint of pepper. Classic Red pairs particularly nicely with pizza and other Italian cuisine with red sauces, peppery beef dishes, and in hardy soups and stews. Cheers!
